#### 1,2,3 POLICY

This season, umpires will be enforcing a new 1,2,3 policy.

-During a game, any haggling, arguing, or other inappropriate behavior by a coach. fan, or player will result in a warning.

- -The next time it happens, a final warning will begin
- -If it happens a third time, the game will be called

#### COACHES RESPONSIBILITY

-Coaches are responsible for all their coaches, players, parents, and fans.

-If anyone on your bench or sideline is being inappropriate, it is your responsibility to remind them of the zero tolerance policy and shut it down

- End the game smoothly shows class in victory & defeat




# BOB ROBERTSON SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD
